**Roland May** holds a doctorate in architecture and the history of building technology. After studying architecture and urban planning at TU Darmstadt, he worked as a research assistant and lecturer in the Department of History and Theory of Architecture. As a result, he was involved in various research projects as an academic assistant at the Chair of the History of Building Technology and Structural Conservation at BTU Cottbus. Since 2021, he has managed the DFG Priority Program 2255 "Cultural Heritage Construction" as Scientific Curator together with Prof. Werner Lorenz.

May's research is primarily concerned with the building industry of the High Modern Era (ca. 1880-1970). In addition to individual personalities (Paul Bonatz, Franz Dischinger), the focus of his academic work is particularly on traditionalist tendencies in modern architecture, cultural dimensions of construction, and the interrelationships between architecture and engineering.
